

# DIRECTIONS TO LOGON TO THE CLUB YAHOO SITE (5/05/2009)

1. Go to [www.yahoo.com](http://www.yahoo.com). and select “groups”



2. Click on “sign in” upper right corner

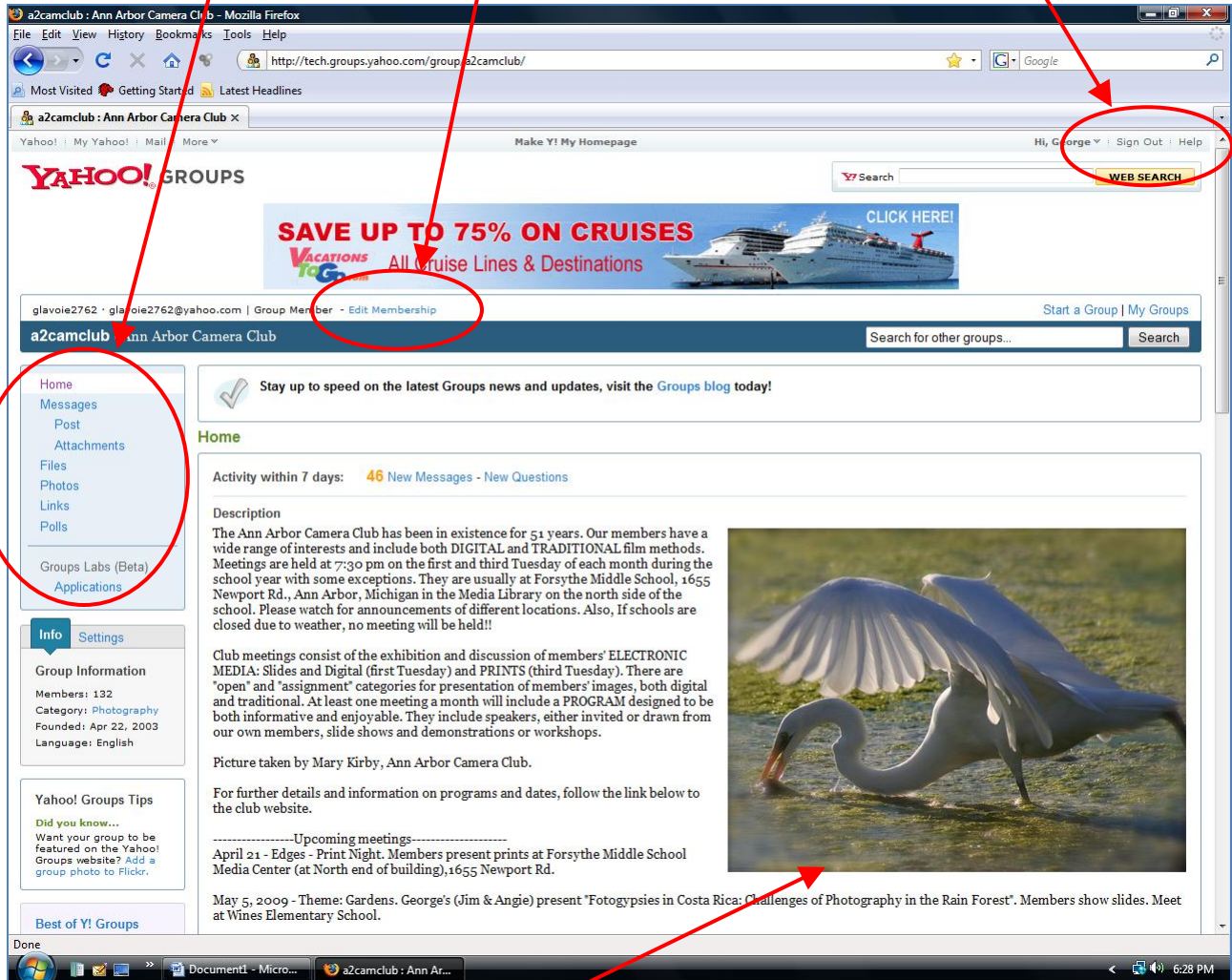

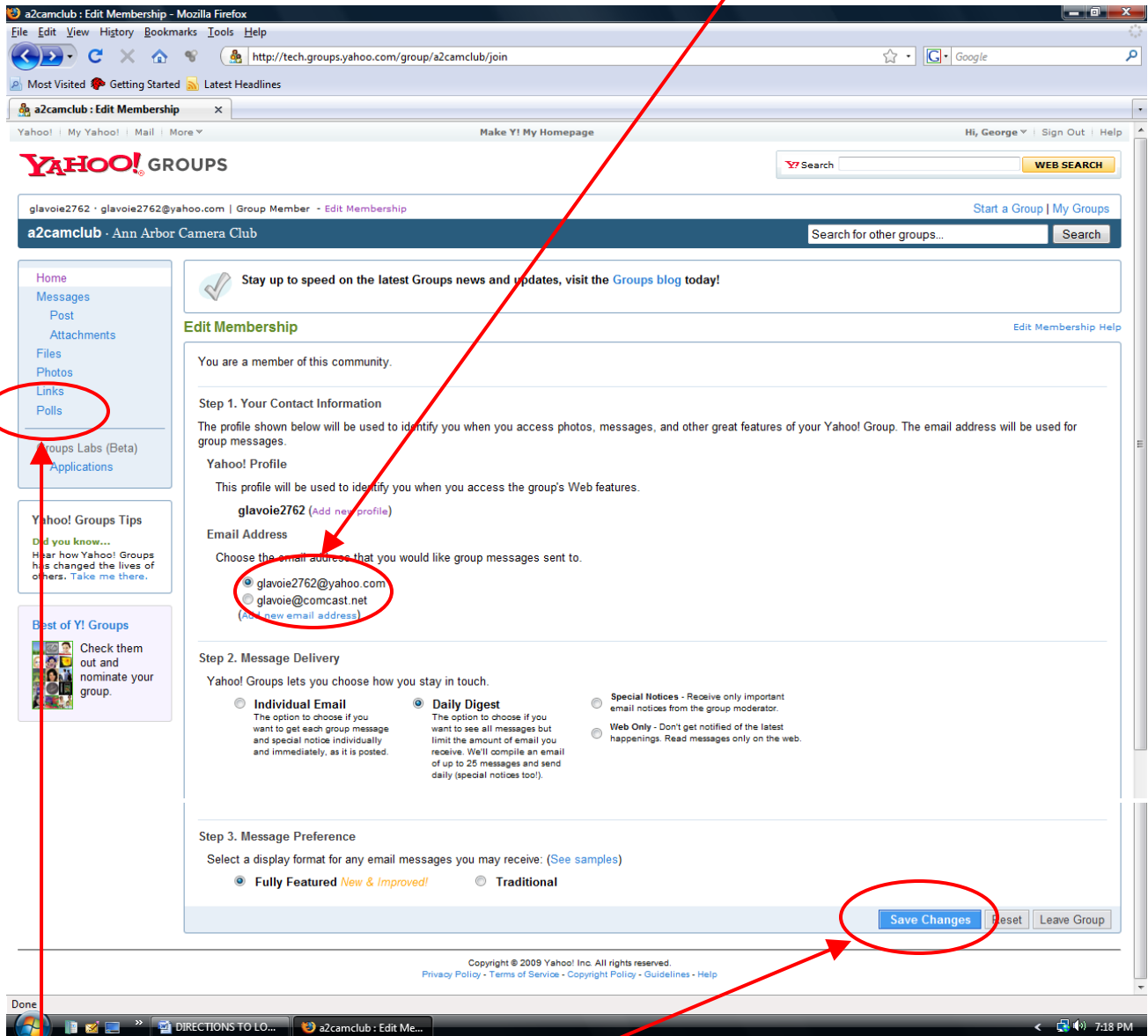
Log out at any time by clicking on “sign out” in upper right corner.
